The PIONEER Alliance, a prestigious European University Alliance Project focused on developing consortium on sustainable cities and smart transportation, was officially launched at Université Gustave Eiffel in Paris. From February 25 to 27, 2025, experts, coordinators, and representatives from ten leading European universities gathered to kick-off this groundbreaking initiative aimed at shaping the future of urban development across Europe.

The vision and ambitions of the PIONEER Alliance, focused on sustainable development and building smart cities. Following this, an exhibition of partner universities took place, providing an ideal space for exchanging experiences and best practices, exploring new opportunities for collaboration and mobility between students, educators and researchers.
